



## How Sculpt & Send works

### 1. Choose your kit

Select the Sculpt & Send kit that best suits your idea and vision. Each one is designed to make bronze casting feel accessible, hands-on and enjoyable at home, whether it is being bought as a gift, a shared activity or a personal creative project.

### 2. Receive everything needed to get started

Inside the kit, you will find specialist sculpting wax, simple sculpting tools, and guidance to help you get started. The materials have been chosen to keep the experience approachable for beginners while still producing a piece that can be professionally cast in bronze.

### 3. Sculpt the piece in wax

Shape your sculpture by hand at home, taking as much or as little time as you like within the return window. The wax is designed specifically for this process. It may feel firm at first, but softens as it warms in the hands, making it easy to shape, refine and rework.

### 4. Complete the return form

Once the sculpture is finished, scan the QR code provided with the kit and complete the online return form. This allows The Lost Foundry to log the sculpture correctly and prepare it for its return to the foundry.

### 5. Receive return instructions and postage details

After the form has been submitted, you will receive the return label details by email from Royal Mail, along with confirmation from The Lost Foundry. At this stage, you may also have the option to choose an upgraded finish, such as polished bronze or verdigris patina, before casting begins.

### 6. Package the wax sculpture and send it back

The completed wax sculpture is carefully packed and taken to the Post Office using the return details supplied. Once it arrives back at the foundry in Devon, the team checks it in and matches it to your returns form.

### 7. The sculpture is cast in solid bronze

The Lost Foundry casts your original wax piece in solid bronze using the traditional lost wax process. This is the same method used in fine-art bronze casting, and it preserves the individuality, surface marks, and character of the original sculpture.

### 8. Finished by hand and returned

After casting, the bronze is cleaned, patinated and finished by hand at the foundry. Once complete, it is carefully packaged and posted back to you, ready to display, gift or keep as a lasting reminder of the making experience.
